**ORDER**

**Subject: Sanction of additional allocation under Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha Evan Uthaan Mahabhiyaan (PM KUSUM) under Component A to the State of Rajasthan**

With reference to the request received for additional demand under Component A of PM KUSUM Scheme from the state of Rajasthan vide letter no CM/Raj/25/Energy/1003250 dated 07.01.2025, the following capacity is allocated to State Implementing Agency:

**Component A**

S. No.	State Implementing Agency	Fresh Allocation (MW)
1	Rajasthan Urja Vikas Nigam Ltd (RUVNL), Rajasthan*	5000

\*State needs to provide the DISCOM-wise bifurcation, if any.

2. The scheme sunset date is March 2026. Thus, the project commissioning timeline shall be till **31 December 2025**. SIAs/Discoms shall submit progress reports and completion reports on the online portal/emails for PM-KUSUM Scheme.
3. SIAs/ Discoms shall follow all the terms and conditions stipulated in the Guidelines of the above mentioned Scheme issued vide Order no. 32/645/2017-SPV Division dated 17.01.2024 and amendments thereof.
4. SIAs/ Discoms shall carry out various activities as mentioned under Section on Responsibilities of State Implementation Agency under PM KUSUM Scheme.
5. SIAs/ Discoms shall be liable for recovery of the whole or part amount of the CFA, with applicable penal interest, in case of non-compliance of the provisions of the Scheme/Sanction.
6. In terms of Rule 230 (7) of GFR 2017 and instructions of DoE, SIAs/ Discoms shall record the receipt of incentives and the expenditure therefrom in the EAT module of PFMS.
7. In terms of the Rule 230 (1) of GFR, concerned SIA/ Discom(s) will certify that they have not obtained or applied for grants for the same purpose or activity from any other Ministry or Department of the Government of India or State Government.
8. In terms of provisions contained in Rule 236(i) of GFR 2017, the account of concerned SIA/Discom(s) shall be open to inspection by the sanctioning authority and audit (both by CAG of



India and Internal Audit by the Principal Accounts Office of the MNRE), whenever the organization is called upon to do so.

9. SIAs/ Discoms will furnish year wise Utilization Certificate (UC) in the prescribed format of GFR-12(A) and Audited Statement of Expenditure (ASoE) along with detailed progress report periodically as per provisions of the scheme.

10. As per Rule 234 of GFR-2017, the sanction has been entered at S. No. 61 & Page No. 14 in the Expenditure Register of this Division.

11. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.

*Respected Sh. Pralhad Joshi ji,*

At the outset, I would like to thank you for your continued support in our endeavour to encourage decentralized solar power generation under the PM-KUSUM scheme.

Few months back, you on our request had agreed for allocation of additional 1000 MW under Component A and 2 lakh agriculture pumps under Component C of the scheme.

I am happy to inform you that out of allocated capacity of 1700 MW under Component A, State has commissioned plants for around 308 MW, executed PPA for another 294 MW and projects of 1000 MW capacity are under tendering. Similarly, under Component C, State has awarded work for 4,547 MW, out of which projects of 91 MW have already been commissioned and for another 1139 MW are at the tendering stage.

State has recently witnessed massive participation in the bids under KUSUM A & C with more than 3000 applications being received under the recent tendering process for 613 Solar Power Projects.

In view of State's potential and capability to become a leader in solar energy, I would request you for allocation of an additional 5,000 MW under Component A (feeder level solarization) of the PM-KUSUM scheme.

This will support the State to further exploit its solar potential and become a bigger part of national energy transition journey while incentivizing growth in rural areas.
